Morphological Techniques in Reproductive Biology

October 13-19, 2011

Content

The course includes lectures on morphological techniques, including pitfalls and applications, lectures and practicals (dissections and microscopy) on the morphology of reproductive organs, and presentations of participating PhD-students' own projects as well as discussions on possible use of morphological techniques.

The course covers reproductive organs of mammals, including gonads, male and female reproductive tracts, early embryonic development, fetal membranes, placenta and the mammary gland.

Preparation

During the course, participants will present their PhD-projects in a short presentation of 5-10 min. There will be time for preparation in the schedule but make sure that you bring material from your project that you wish to use for your presentation.

Prerequisites

MSc degree in animal science, biology, medicine, nursing or equivalent degree including basic mammalian anatomy and physiology.

Cost

There is no course fee but the participants need to cover their costs for travel and accommodation.
