

Nordic Feed Science Conference ---- International Silage Conference



A "Between conferences tour" is offered for those who will attend the International Silage Conference in Hämeenlinna, Finland on 2-4 of July. Visit Stockholm on Saturday 30 June and depart 5 pm by a cruising ship and spend the bright summer night in the beautiful archipelago between Sweden and Finland. At Sunday morning (10 am) you wake up in Helsinki and can finish the week-end by sight-seeing the capital of Finland. Prices vary from about SEK 880 (single in a shared budget cabin) to about SEK 3700 (total for two persons in luxury cabin including dinner and breakfast). **Booking instructions are found further down in this document (Updated March 28)**

Mid-conference tour Stockholm-Helsinki

Will You attend both the 3rd Nordic Feed Science Conference in Uppsala and the International Silage Conference in Helsinki? We then recommend you to combine the journey between the conferences with a sight-seeing activity.

The 3rd Nordic Feed Science Conference in Uppsala terminates in the afternoon Friday 29th of June. One alternative is to go to Stockholm, the capital of Sweden situated at the sea. You travel to Stockholm by train for 1 hour, tickets are purchased at the railway station. We suggest you to book a hotel in Stockholm, and after sight-seeing Stockholm during the Saturday you board the ferry to Helsinki at around 17:00 hours in afternoon. For hotel and ferry booking see below. The ferries are luxurious with several restaurants and a variety of bed/cabin alternatives.

Sunday morning you wake up in Helsinki, the capital of Finland, after a wonderful trip through the world's largest archipelago in the bright Nordic summer night. You can spend the Sunday sight-seeing Helsinki before taking the train to Hämeenlinna and the International Silage Conference. For timetable and tickets, see <http://www.vr.fi/en/index.html> . The journey takes 1-1,5 hours.

Hotel booking:

Ferry booking:

There are two ferry companies going from Stockholm to Helsinki. You can book and pay online. Note that early booking is needed for travelling in June.

- Choose 'Route': if you are going one way or round trip, but home some days later. Choose 'Cruise': for round trip (2 nights onboard and 1 day in Helsinki).
- Early bird booking offers a lower rate and is possible with payments ≥ 21 days in advance
- Viking Line terminal is located some hundred meters from subway station "Slussen", very close to the shopping and tourist area "Old town".
