# The national standard for educations in nature guiding



- Educations that meet the requirements of the standard are approved.
- Students that passes get diploma.
- Approved educations are preparatory to the certification
- Principal association is FUN.

## The certification system for nature guides



- Need practical experience and theoretical knowledge
- Written and guiding test.
- Independent examiners
- Gets diploma, name tag and logo to use.
- Lasts for three years.

# High schools (gymnasier)

49 agricultural collages (naturbruksgymnasier) with nature tourism Program in nature tourism:

- Content close to education standard
- Preparatory to certification

#### **Trends:**

- In 2021 high school programme in nature tourism
- Students increased with 15 % between 2019 and 2022
