

## Thulin Bullets for Biodiversity [in Sweden]

- Animal-indexing of areal land-use subsidies – more animals, wild & domestic, equals more subsidies
- Offer full cost coverage for large predator preventive actions such as fencing
- Set aside at least one quart of all conventional agricultural land for biodiversity-promotion (e.g. birdfields, wildlife crops, edge zones, fallows)
- Set aside at least one quart of all clear-cut areas for free development and/or woodland grazing
- Limit spruce plantation to at most one quart area of all individual clear-cuttings
- Distribute free broadleaved plants for reforestation
- Preserve deciduous trees during thinning and clear cutting
- Implement organised forest-fires, in particular where spruce density is high
- Extend subsidies for reestablishment of pastures, in particular of spruce forests planted on old meadows and grooves
- Introduce a total hunting ban for five consecutive years (then start again with a pronounced resource perspective and well developed manage plans with focus food, environment and diversity)
- Encourage supplementary release of musk oxen, fallow deer, European beaver, mofflon and European rabbit
- Reintroduce European bison (wisent), saiga antelope, wild reindeer, wildcat, great bustard, black stork, European roller, middle spotted woodpecker, barn owl, European pond turtle, sturgeon
- Dedomesticate cattle and horse



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
