Practical skills in sequence analysis, 2 HEC (PNS0191)

The course will be conducted remotely via Zoom. The course will consist of five scheduled afternoon group sessions with time for independent study in between. Course participants will view prerecorded lectures and perform their own analyses between sessions and then discuss their progress with the course leader and other course participants at each session.
