

SLU Refund Policy

The following circumstances constitute legitimate reasons for a full refund in the event the student has paid the tuition fee and the payment has been registered by the Department of Financial Administration at SLU.

Circumstance	Possibility of refund
The student applies for a residence permit to the Swedish Migration Agency, but is denied a residence permit.	A full refund will be made.
The student applies for deferment of studies prior to commencing studies.	If deferment is granted, the tuition fee will be kept by the university until the studies begin.
The student is conditionally admitted and do not meet the entry requirements two weeks after the enrolment day.	A full refund will be made.
The student's fee status has been altered due to, for instance, EU/EEA citizenship.	A refund will be made.
There are other special circumstances that can be supported.	A refund will be made.
The student declines the offer of a place on the degree programme prior to commencing studies or does not commence their studies.	No refund is made.
The student is expelled from studies by a ruling of the Higher Education Expulsions Board, or suspended from classes by a ruling of the Disciplinary Board.	No refund is made.
The student has been admitted to studies on false merits and the admissions decision has since been rescinded.	No refund is made.
The student's residence permit has been revoked.	No refund is made.

- The student must actively apply for a refund and submit documentation that supports their claim of a legitimate reason for a refund.
- No interest is paid on refunds.
- Refunds are made exclusively to the same account that the payment of the tuition fee was made from.
- The decision to grant a refund is made by the Head of the Division of Educational Affairs at SLU.
