#### § 1 Meeting was opened

- a) Mattias Thelander was appointed secretary
- b) Peter Bozhkov was appointed adjustor
- c) Last meeting protocol was approved with the addition that Christina Dixelius chaired it.
- d) Additional questions:
  - Miguel: Need for new PhD representative from Forest Mycology and Plant Pathology
  - Christina: Which documents related to OB needs to be archived?

## § 2 Final reports from concluded activities

- a) Introduction to Bioinformatics using NGS data: Lina reported that this course was given by SciLifeLab and that only 2 OB PhD students took it. The research school has not yet been billed for their participation but since the maximum cost will be SEK 2 x 1800 the report was approved anyway.
- b) Mycology its basics and state-of-the-art applications, 3 HEC: The end report was postponed to a later meeting since Petra was not present.
- c) Multivariate statistics, 4.5 HEC: Lina reported that this course was a collaboration between OB, Ecology and FOSW and was organised by Ulf Grandin and colleagues. 22 persons attended the core course while 8 completed the project part. Evaluation scores were high. Costs were slightly lower than budgeted since so few students attended the project part. The report was approved.
- d) How to write and publish a scientific paper, 4.5 HEC: The end report was postponed to a later meeting since Petra was not present.

## § 3 Progress reports from ongoing and planned spring activities

- a) Visualize your science: Mattias reported that the course is filled to the last place and is ongoing.
- b) To communicate science: Mattias reported that this course collaboration between all NJ research school was recently concluded but that an end report is still missing.
- c) Workshop: Mattias reported that planning has proceeded in line with what was discussed in our last meeting and that the workshop was advertised by e-mail a few days before the meeting.

### § 4 Mobility support application from Johnny Östman (attached)

a) A unanimously decision was taken to grant the application with a sum of SEK 10.000 kr.

## § 5 Budget update

- a) Mattias reminded the meeting about the total resources granted by the faculty
  - SEK 4.894.000 was granted for the entire four year period (July 17 to June21)
  - We are allowed to use 30% of these funds for coordinator salaries (SEK 1.468.200)
  - This means that SEK 3.425.800 is available for activities for the entire four year periods which equals an average of SEK 428.225 per semester.

- a) Miguel informed that he will soon defend his thesis which means that a new PhD representative from Forest Mycology and Plant Pathology should be engaged in the steering committee. It was decided that Miguel should ask around and inform the coordinators about interested candidates well before the next steering committee meeting.
- b) Christina brought up the possible need for archiving of formal documents such as course syllabi etc. Mattias and Lina informed that such documents have been saved but not archived hitherto. It was decided that discussion should be continued at a future meeting when Christina has found out what kind of documents that are supposed to be archived.

### § 8 Time for next meeting

It was decided that the two next-coming meetings should take place in October and December, respectively. To find suitable dates, it was decided that the coordinators should send out a doodle.
