Workshops

Workshops

Studio II - Housing in an urban context

Description:

During the second year of the landscape architect programme, students take their second studio course which introduces them to urban design and urban development. The course provides an understanding of how the living environment can be designed as part of a cohesive urban landscape based on local conditions.

During this workshop, the opportunity is given to gain insight into a specially adapted critique element in the course. The students present the structural plans they have developed for the new district of Västerbro in Lund.

Design teaching and research at SLU

Description:

This is the first of two workshops within the CFI-project Site impressions in sustainable landscape design - network activities to strengthen design research at SLU, gathering teachers, researchers, students and practitioners with interest in urban landscapes and their design. In this network activity we explore how site impressions/aesthetic environmental experiences, connecting embodied poly-sensual experience to critical reflection, can become recognized to contribute to creating sustainable urban landscapes.

The overall objective is to strengthen collaboration and knowledge exchange in the subject field of landscape design at the LAPF and SOL departments, and make design work at SLU more visible. Furthermore, our ambition is to initiate conversations with other universities, for inspiration and knowledge exchange supporting design research at SLU, and shed light on the potential for a more long-term capacity building initiative, here suggested as a "SLU Landscape Design Research Forum".

The workshop consists of a round table discussion and an outdoor activity.

Round table discussion (1h)

Teachers, students, researchers and practitioners, exchange experiences with design teaching and research at Alnarp and Ultuna. We discuss design courses at Alnarp and Ultuna, and student projects and master thesis projects involving design research.

Outdoor activity (1h)

In the Landscape Lab we experiment with encountering sites through observation and performative drawing.

Title:

The importance of urban green environments to meet future challenges

Description:

The attitude around the city's green elements has in recent years become increasingly positive and where we today increasingly discuss its great value and importance in meeting future challenges. With this increasing focus on what the city's trees and other vegetation can help us to meet future challenges, the demands on us who design and plan these green elements will increase with demands for a significantly higher accuracy around the right plant and plant design for the right place and function, as in the future we will not agree to replace plants that have not established themselves or developed successfully. In Henrik's presentation, a future exploration of the challenges that landscape architecture faces in the development of long-term sustainable cities will be presented with thoughts on how and why we must take on these challenges.


