CHAIR/Vice chair (CD/ISH)

CD is happy to step up as chair with the support of ISH.

WG (GL)

GL had sent a written report prior to the meeting with the following info:

Anna Robling is new contact person for the WG while Lisa Norfall is on parental leave.

A planning group for the spring SLU:L Days is slowly been formed. Anna Maria Pálsdottir from ISM is the first member.

Maria Wisselgren is following up on launching the granted CFI projects.

PhD Forum have stated a new series of meeting PhD-colloquiums that seems to work well with newly enrolled students.

Teachers Forum are planning for new online meetings for the spring.

Movium (CD)

Many things happening but of general interest might be that Movium is strengthening the collaboration with UF in terms of transdisciplinarity and synthesis and are planning to recruit one new facilitator with this as its specific task.

SOL (BS)

The reorganization of the division in two subgroups with two different heads have continued. Bruno is still deputy head of department but will split the day-to-day responsibilities with Åsa Ahrland who will be responsible for one of the two groups.

LJ added that the event on Gestaltad Livsmiljö together with Arkitekturakademin and ArkDes on January 19 was successful and that the collaboration continues.

LAPF (ISH)

Not present.

ISM (CH)

The department has a new name! The department also have a couple of new employees, doctoral student Anna Lit, senior lecturer Anna Maria Pálsdottir and one more position to be decided. The multiscensorial outdoor lab (SENSOLA) is progressing with Gunnar Cerwén working as apost doc.

UF (NV)

Confirms CD's info on strengthened collaboration with Movium. Collaboration with SLU Global is growing. In their collaboration agreement for 2021 a seminar series is planned, debating diverse issues of sustainable urban development in the global south, linking to SDGs, as well as a "Policy Lab" is formed, harvesting from those seminars, which can act as a forum for critical policy discussions within SLU. Discussions with Umeå municipality continues with the aim of drafting an agreement, similar to the existing agreement with Uppsala municipality.
