This project supported the development of an EU H2020 application submitted in February 2019; CONEXUS: co-producing regeneration ecosystems - transdisciplinary nexus for urban sustainability.

The funding was used to participate in two workshops held during the preparation of the proposal; Rome (May, 2018), and Bogota (November, 2018).

CONEXUS is led by University of Sheffield, with SLU as co-lead. CONEXUS will structure, coordinate and promote access to the shared, contextualised knowledge needed to support cities and communities to co-create NBS and together restore urban ecosystems to help drive the required step-change in urban policy and practice in European and CELAC countries.
