Quick facts about Stockholm Resilience Centre (SRC)

- **Launched** in 2007
- A joint initiative between **Stockholm University** and the **Beijer Institute of Econological Economics** at The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences
- Located within the faculty of Science at Stockholm University
- All staff under one roof
 - Around 90 researchers (including 10 Post Docs and 20-25 PhD-students)
 - Communications, policy, “secretariates” (18)
 - Support and administration (10)
- **18** Master’s students annually

Key characteristics of cross-disciplinary research at SRC

- Curiosity driven fundamental research in the Anthropocene
- Question driven (not capacity driven) research
- Framed creativity and encouragement of pluralism
- Science excellence at the core
- Epistemological agility and methodological groundedness
- Trust and Culture
