## 1 - HACKATHON

The programme starts on **26 September** with a **Hackathon and matchmaking event** focused on ideation/ preliminary development of the initial ideas and team formulation.

# 2 - MENTORING PROGRAMME

The best teams from the hackathon are invited to continue in the mentoring programme that includes **3 intense development days** focused on topics such as sustainable product development and MVP, sales and marketing, fundraising (public and private), pitching skills. This is complemented by **1:1 mentoring**. Preliminary schedule:

Session 2: 10 November

## 3 - DEMO DAY

At the final event of the programme - preliminary date **15 December** - all teams will **pitch to an international jury** (key mentors, RD&I innovation ecosystem stakeholders and investors) that will provide feedback and announce the **top 3** who will receive awards provided by NOBALIS partners and other stakeholders.
