
Formas assignment from the government

- Stimulate impact and utilization of research


From 1 Januari 2018

Formas budget 1,7 billion SEK 2019



Why different funding instruments?

Portfolio – makes it possible to embrace more perspectives

Different types of funding instruments

Recurrent and continuous calls, e.g. annual open call

Thematic calls, initiated by Formas or by the Government

National research programmes, thematic calls in 10-year programmes with strategic research agendas, cooperation with other funders and actors

Strategic Innovation Programmes (SIP), long-term programmes run by industry, funded by Formas, Vinnova and the Swedish Energy Agency

International cooperation calls e.g. within EU or Belmont Forum

Formas annual open call

Projects within Formas' all areas

Research & development projects and mobility grants ~1300 applications per year, success rate 15-20 %

Purpose: enable researchers to address self-identified research needs

Evaluation of applications performed in thematic review panels

- Experts in panels have complimentary competences and the panels can evaluate disciplinary, trans- and interdisciplinary research
- The focus of the review panels are inspired by the SDGs



Global and national societal challenges

- Sweden should be in lead of work with Agenda 2030
- Transformation is needed!
