



PVG0042 Questionnaire Design and Management, 3.0 credits

PhD course arranged by Graduate School for Veterinary Medicine and Animal Sciences (GS-VMAS)

Course date: May 16-20, 2022

Location: Uppsala

Content

The course will consist of a series of lectures, exercises and journal discussions. Two key issues related to questionnaire design and management will be covered, as well as methods for evaluating and dealing with missing data. Multiple imputation to handle missing observations will be tackled.

After completing the course the student shall be able to

- describe the principles of questionnaire design
- explain the psychology of respondent communication
- construct questionnaire studies and manage incoming data with high internal and external validity
- understand the basis for the development of measurement scales
- use a variety of methods (including item response theory models) to evaluate a measurement scale based on questionnaire data

Prerequisites

Admitted to a postgraduate program in animal science, biology, veterinary medicine, food science, nutrition, nursing, or related subjects, or to a residency program in veterinary science
