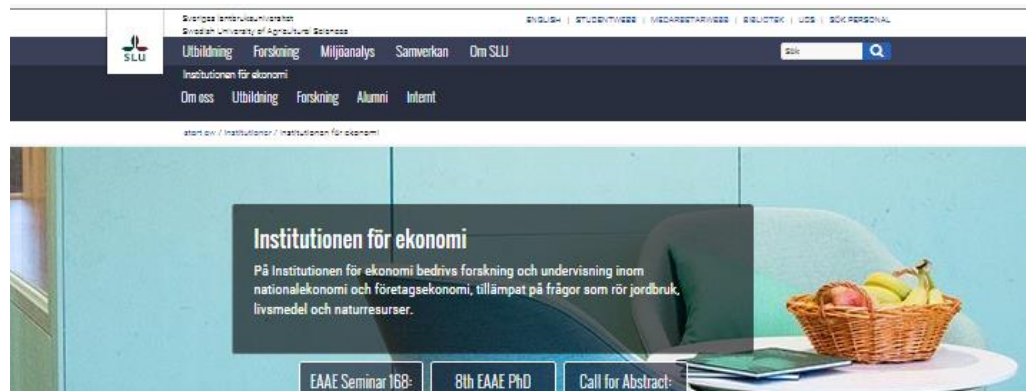

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PRME

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The PRME SIP Policy requires signatories to submit and publish a SIP report to the PRME website at least once every two years. When a signatory fails to meet its submission deadline, it will be designated as "non-communicating."

Timely submission of a SIP report at least once every two years is required of all signatories to PRME. This report serves as a way for your institution to publicly communicate its progress on the implementation of the Six Principles of PRME advancing the values of responsibility, sustainability, and ethics.

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Six Principles

As institutions of higher education involved in the development of current and future managers we declare our willingness to progress in the implementation, within our institution, of the following Principles, starting with those that are more relevant to our capacities and mission. We will report on progress to all our stakeholders and exchange effective practices related to these principles with other academic institutions:

- Principle 1 | Purpose:** We will develop the capabilities of students to be future generators of sustainable value for business and society at large and to work for an inclusive and sustainable global economy. 
- Principle 2 | Values:** We will incorporate into our academic activities, curricula, and organisational practices the values of global social responsibility as portrayed in international initiatives such as the United Nations Global Compact. 
- Principle 3 | Method:** We will create educational frameworks, materials, processes and environments that enable effective learning experiences for responsible leadership. 
- Principle 4 | Research:** We will engage in conceptual and empirical research that advances our understanding about the role, dynamics, and impact of corporations in the creation of sustainable social, environmental and economic value. 
- Principle 5 | Partnership:** We will interact with managers of business corporations to extend our knowledge of their challenges in meeting
