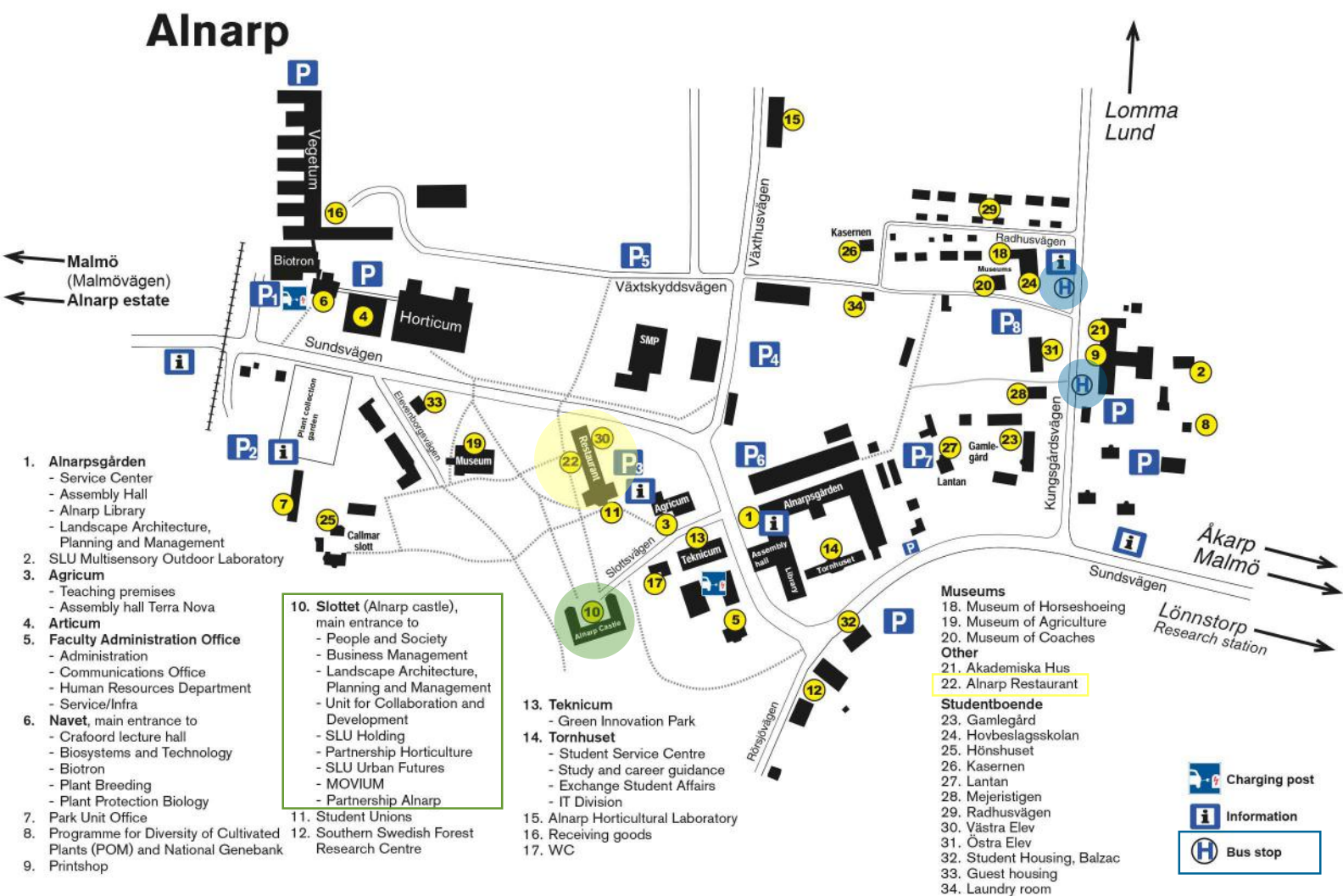




Event Map
