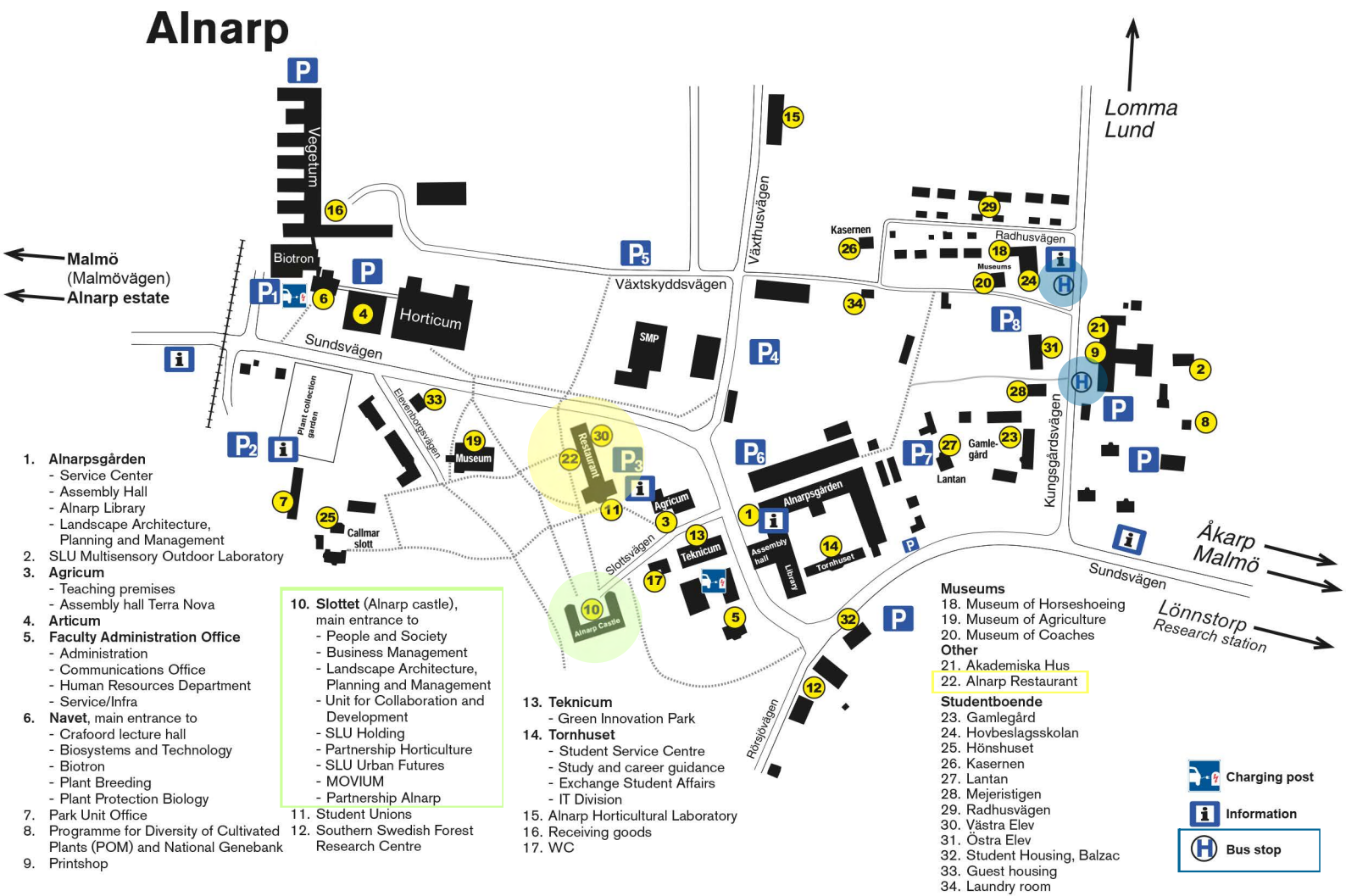




Event Map
