INTRODUCTION

- Municipalities in NL started to pay deeper attention to the conditions of the urban bridges and quay walls (UBQs).
- Planning strategies were created to improve the conditions of the UBQs.
- Attention is given to extending their lifespan.
- A collapse event of a UBQ in 2020 ringed alarms

- Monitoring activities are conducted to know their current conditions.
- Physical checkups and sensors are used to collect data about the UBQs.
- However, stakeholder participation is seen as one of the main conditions for a successful renovation program in asset management strategies.





<u>In Amsterdam</u>, the Program Bridges and Quay Walls promote a strategy to improve their conditions through different activities, among them studying the UBQs physical condition through different monitoring activities.

In The Hague, to strengthen, replace, renovate and maintain the UBQs, the Gemeente located these tasks within the Long-term Program for Structures initiated in 2011 and the Multi-Year Programme for Artworks



7-11-2022 | There are many quay walls and bridges in The Hague. The municipality keeps a close eye on them. Many of these old quay walls and bridges rest on a wooden base (foundation). These are often affected by a bacterium. The municipality replaces the bridges and quay walls according to a fixed plan.

- Studies have emphasised the need to involve stakeholders in asset management strategies to improve the long-term planning of urban water infrastructure.
- Nevertheless, there are challenges perceived between asset managers and stakeholders, such as **ambiguous and indistinct points of view of stakeholders' ambitions.**

This makes successful participation challenging to achieve.

- There is **limited research** on integrating stakeholder participation and monitoring of the UBQs to improve risk communication.
- The government align and manages emergency risk strategies based on **expert advice**, not considering residents' input.
- This leads to **ignoring the local residents' input**, causing a failure to translate strategies that consider societal needs and **creating conflict among asset users** (residents) **and asset owners** (local governments)
- How various stakeholders perceive monitoring information and how risk communication is conducted and associated with the UBQs is unknown.

Some of Amsterdam's bridges and quays are on the verge of collapse



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Overview

- de BouwApp was suggested to inform about the works being conducted.
- Social media groups were not that relevant.
- Newspapers provided several information to the residents.
- Asset owners contacted directly the residents around the canal through printed mail.
- The visiting centre worked as a space for information meetings.










FINDINGS



Residents discuss official decisions and propose solutions using social media channels



- There is no visiting centre to inform about the works being developed or future actions.
- **Printed mail** with advice and postcards from asset owners to asset users.
- **De BouwApp is recommended** by asset owners to be installed to know information about the works in progress.
- Informational videos, reports, and news are posted on the municipality's website. Difficult to find.
- A better graphic design is mentioned that could improve communication, as suggested by asset owners.





MAIN FINDINGS

- Actions were taken first to improve the conditions of the UBQs.
- Collecting data for monitoring the UBQs is made by service providers; they do not collect residents' input.
- Information about the maintenance working process is shown through the BowApp.
- Information meetings were conducted to present information about the works developed; nevertheless, in previous stages, asset users were not involved.
- Some asset users have a high education level, which has made the acceptance of solutions provided by asset owners.
- The asset users were not involved in planning or design stages, just informed about already taken actions.
- Some residents present their own solutions developed by retired experts.

RESEARCH RECOMMENDATIONS

- Translate statistical information into more digestible forms for the ordinary citizen
- Stakeholder participation and discussions can bring awareness and acceptance of UBQ maintenance
- Visual and graphic information is essential. Even interactive information.
- Monitoring data can also inform asset users if it is translated properly
