Seeing the forest in the trees: Creating possibilities for spontaneous communication during woodland walks	Much of what people know about forest management has reached them via media — often driven by a polarised debate. The goal of this project is to explore the usefulness of app-based self-guided communication for forest visitors. The project created an opportunity for forest visitors to engage with different perspectives on the past, present and possible futures of a specific forest site. The idea was piloted at six locations in or near Uppsala during February-April 2023.	Short digital questionnaire on people's perceptions of forest management, exploring strengths and weaknesses of digital surveys as a tool for communication, by means of a QR code linked to a dedicated app prepared by the project partner Greensway. The responses received will be evaluated to further develop the questions and the implementation of the app. The results will be useful in a practical context, since many organisations are looking to develop self-guided ways of communicating with visitors about the environment and its management.
