



Accommodation at SLU in Umeå



SLU Student Housing in Umeå

Umeå is in the north of Sweden. SLU's student housing has 16 student accommodation sites around the city. All accommodation is shared student housing, where each student has their own room with private bathroom and shares a kitchen with other residents. All rooms are 20m². The monthly rent is listed under each property. SLU Umeå shares its campus with Umeå University, the fifth largest university in Sweden.





General information

Unlike many other housing companies, SLU Umeå student housing only has a two-month notice period. Please respect this when you decide to terminate your accommodation contract. You must terminate your contract in writing, either via email or letter.

All student accommodation is only intended for students, unless otherwise stated. Sharing single rooms with another person is not permitted and will result in eviction.





Housing waiting list

Students who want to live in SLU accommodation must register on the waiting list. This also applies to the students who are guaranteed accommodation, as the guarantee is only valid for students on the waiting list. Read more below.

Who needs to sign up for the housing waiting list?

All students are required to sign up for the SLU accommodation waiting list if they want to apply for university housing. Students who are guaranteed university accommodation have to register as well, as the guarantee only applies to students on the waiting list. Students wishing to utilise the guarantee must register before 1 May. Students without accommodation guarantee have to register from 1 May for housing the upcoming school year. The following students are guaranteed accommodation:

- * Fee-paying students
- * SLU scholarship holders
- * Swedish Institute scholarship holders.



Register for the waiting list

Usually included in our accommodation:

Heating, water, electricity, waste collection, furniture in the room being rented (bed (90x200cm), duvet (150x200cm), pillow (50x60cm), desk, chair, wardrobe, book case, fire alarm). You can bring your own smaller items of furniture, such as bedside tables, however please note that you may not get rid of the existing furniture in the room. The room is rented with the existing furniture. As a resident you are responsible for keeping your room, its furniture and the common areas clean and tidy. Rent also includes access to laundry facilities.



Not usually included in our accommodation:

TV, telephone line, internet/Wi-Fi (connection is available but you will need to arrange your own subscription with a provider) and insurance. Bed sheets, washing powder, detergents, dishcloths, etc. are also <u>not</u> included.







Before moving out


• Two-month notice period for both tenants and SLU student housing. You must submit your notice to SLU student housing two calendar months before you intend to move out. You must arrange an inspection at least two weeks in advance by emailing housing@slu.se. The inspection will take place on the day you move out and will be performed by your rental company. Please note that inspections are only offered on weekdays between 08:00 and 15:00. You will need to find alternative accommodation if you will be moving out on a weekend or at any other time that prevents the inspection taking place in connection with your departure. You must be present during the inspection.

You will be charged SEK 2 000 if you fail to clean your room thoroughly.
